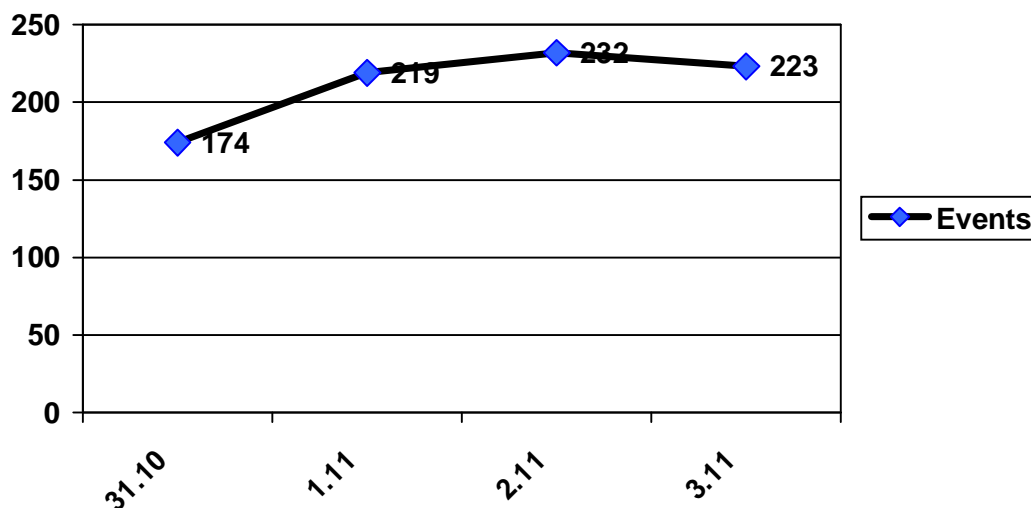

THE DYNAMICS OF THE M.A.I. ACTIVITIES

A 21% decrease in the road traffic accidents comparing with last week

Between October 31 and November 3 2005, the personnel within the Ministry of Administration and Interior **recorded 848 events**, the evolution of the identified events increasing day by day, this fact emphasising that each M.A.I. structure seriously involved in completing their assignments in the field of public order and safety.



Making an analysis of the effectiveness of the activities accomplished by the personnel of each M.A.I. unit with attributions in preventing and countering the illegal deeds recorded at the level of our country, the situation is as follows:

A. THE ROMANIAN POLICE GENERAL INSPECTORATE

Over the above-mentioned period of time (October 31-November 3, 2005), the personnel of the Romanian Police identified **423 criminal deeds and minor offences**, the most of them being of judicial nature - **143 criminal deeds**.

There were identified **45 economic-financial crimes**, out of which **9 fiscal evasions**.

At the same time, there were identified and taken in custody **309 persons charged with having committed different minor offences**; out of them, **21 persons had been subject to manhunt**, being wanted for having committed different kind of crimes in Romania.

After analysing the road traffic-related events, one can notice that the **number of the accidents over the past 4 days recorded a 21% decrease comparing with the similar period last week** (between 24-27 October 2005 there were recorded 105 accidents, and between 31 October-3 November – 83 accidents), in parallel being recorded an **increase in the number of the penal files drawn up by the personnel of the Road Police** (for different crimes relating to road traffic as well as for other types of crimes), **as last week there were recorded 139, and this week – 145**.

B. GENERAL INSPECTORATE OF THE ROMANIAN GENDARMERIE

The personnel of this institution continued carrying out different missions meant to ensure the public order and safety in the competence zone, accomplishing **1,351 missions – independently of in cooperation with other institutions**. During these actions, **there were identified 704 persons** who had committed different minor offences, the **fines applied amounting to 158,859 RON**.

C. THE BORDER POLICE GENERAL INSPECTORATE

During the reference period, the border police officers took actions for preventing and countering the cross-border crimes in the competence zones, recording **78 border-related events** (53 – at the level of the cross-border control points and 25 at the level of the “green” border). On this occasion, there were identified – independently of in cooperation with other institutions – **goods destined to be traded on the “black market”** (smuggled) amounting to **1,042,317 RON**, as well as **4,090 persons** (Romanian and foreign citizens) who did not fulfil the required legal conditions so as to be allowed to cross the Romanian border (when both entering and leaving the country) – this number also including the persons involved in committing different illegal deeds.

D. THE GENERAL INSPECTORATE FOR EMERGENCY SITUATIONS

The personnel of this institution intervened in **294 events**, out of which **137 fires** and **88 cases of granting first aid in different emergency situations**, in order to protect/ rescue the persons affected, as well as their goods. Comparing with the period 24-27 October 2005, when there were identified 112 fires, there was recorded a **22% increase in the number of this kind of events** occurred at the level of our country, in the above-mentioned period of time.

E. THE AUTHORITY FOR ALIENS

Taking into consideration the negative effects of the illegal migration of the foreign citizens in Romania (persons who entered legally in our country but who were afterwards identified illegally staying or working in Romania), the personnel of this institution continued accomplishing control actions at the level of the entire country – **66 actions carried out** over the period 31 October – 3 November 2005 – being **identified 29 foreign citizens illegally staying in Romania**. At the same time, there were **sanctioned 101 persons for different minor offences, the fines applied amounting to 26,900 RON**.

Between October 31 and November 3, 2005, different actions - meant to come in the service of citizens - were also taken by the **General Directorate of Passports**, the **National Inspectorate for Persons' Record** and the **Directorate of Driving Licenses and Registration Certificates Regime**; thus, there were issued: **13,111 travel documents**, **19,074 identity documents**, **3,863 driving licenses** and **7,954 registration certificates**.

The personnel of the Ministry of Administration and Interior will keep on carrying out different actions meant to prevent and counter the illegal actions, so that all people obey the legislation in force; their actions are also aimed at ensuring the public order and calmness, as well as at improving Romania's image abroad.

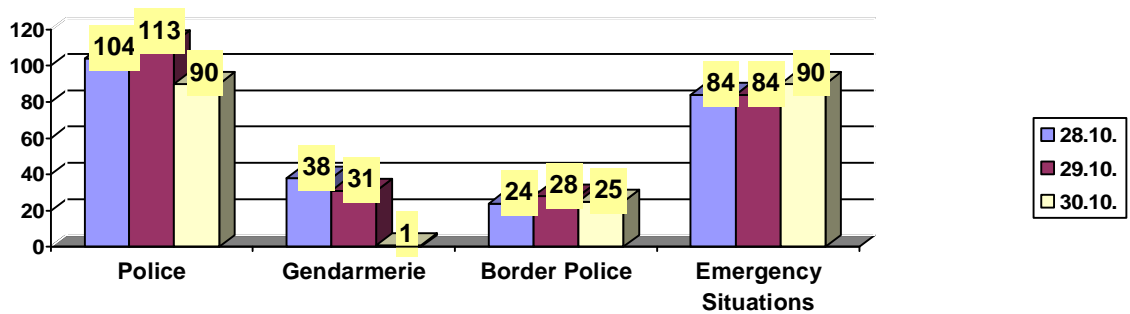

M.A.I. ACTIONS DURING THIS WEEK-END.

During the 3 days of this week-end, 22 persons who had been subject to manhunt were taken in custody by the M.A.I. personnel.

This week-end, the personnel of the Ministry of Administration and Interior recorded **725 events**, this representing a 9% increase comparing with last week-end, when there had been recorded **662 events**.

The evolution by days and by subordinate structures of M.A.I. is presented in the chart below:



The detailed situation is as follows:

1. The Romanian Police General Inspectorate: there were identified **307** offences, out of which **128** of judicial nature and **25** of economic-financial nature. The personnel of the Road Police identified **71** road traffic minor offences and recorded **83** traffic accidents which resulted in **33** deceased and **61** seriously injured persons. During the specific actions and controls organized to fight the criminal phenomenon, **there were identified and taken in custody 246 suspects of certain crimes**, out of whom **22 persons who had been subject to manhunt**.

2. The Romanian Gendarmerie General Inspectorate: accomplished, during the above-mentioned interval of time, **1,103 missions for keeping and preserving the public order** - independently or in cooperation with other institutions - and applied **582 sanctions** for minor offences amounting to over **118,700 RON**.

3. The Border Police General Inspectorate: The border police officers identified **77 border events**, 52 at the level of the cross-border control points and 25 at the level of the "green" border. A number of **2,529** Romanian citizens were not allowed to leave the country and **324** Romanian citizens were sent back from different countries, based on readmission agreements. At the same time, **562 foreign citizens** were not allowed to cross the border (when both entering and leaving Romania) and - independently or in cooperation with other institutions - there were taken over in order to be seized goods amounting to over **256,400 RON**.

4. The General Inspectorate for Emergency Situations: intervened in **258** events, out of which **119** fires and **14** extrications; they also granted first aid in **90** emergency situations.

5. The Authority for Aliens: there were accomplished **48** controls, being applied sanctions for different minor offences to **99** foreign citizens, the fines amounting to approximately **22,500 RON**.
