MINISTER VASILE BLAGA PARTICIPATES
TO THE REUNION OF MINISTERS OF JUSTICE AND INTERNAL AFFAIRS
WITHIN THE COOPERATION PROCESS
OF THE STATES FROM SOUTH-EASTERN EUROPE

Tomorrow, 8th of February 2006, **Vasile Blaga**, the Minister of Administration and Internal Affairs participates, at Loutraki – Greece, to the **Reunion of Ministers of Justice and Internal Affairs within the Cooperation Process of the States from South-Eastern Europe (SEECP)**.

The manifestation – *the second of this kind, developed according to the schedule of actions* of the Greek Current Presidency *of SEECP* – includes debates in plenum and at the experts level, focused on the strengthening of the cooperation within the fight against terrorism and human beings traffic, as well as the evaluation of the progresses achieved in fighting against organized crime and corruption, according to the priorities of action established by the Common Statement of SEECP from Bucharest, 18th of May 2005.

The peak moment of the reunion is represented by the adopting of the **Commune Statement of the ministers of justice and internal affairs** of the states participating to the Process of Cooperation in South-Eastern Europe, approach that intends the **reinforcement of the cooperation in preventing the human beings traffic and terrorism**.

This reunion confirms once again the preoccupation of the states from the South-Eastern Europe for providing the stability, security and good neighboring in the area, desideratum achievable only by means of an intense institutional collaboration at international level.
