**Internationally Wanted person, suspect of having committed murder, retained in Galati**

Thanks to a good co-operation and an operational data and information exchange between Interpol Bureau in Rome and the National Interpol Bureau in Bucharest - within the International Police Co-operation Centre of M.A.I., an internationally wanted person suspect of murder was retained in Galati, yesterday.

Thus, based on the Italian Interpol Bureau's application regarding the pre-trial custody in view of extradition in Italy of **PREDA DORU**, aged 36, from Tecuci, Galati County, and on the order issued by the Prosecutor's Office near the Court of Appeal from Galati, the above mentioned person was retained by the police officers within the Criminal Investigation Department – Police Inspectorate of Galati County around the municipality, and presented before the Court of Appeal from Galati for the legal actions to be taken.

The suspect was internationally wanted by the Italian authorities for having committed, in Torino, first degree murder and aggravated robbery on an Italian citizen.

A 30-day pre-trial arrest warrant was issued on the suspect's name, in view of his extradition, and presently he is taken in custody in the arrest of C.P.I.Galati.
