## MILITARY ORDINANCE no. 11 of May, the 11<sup>th</sup> 2020 on measures for preventing the spread of COVID-19

Considering the provisions of art.24 of the Government Emergency Ordinance no. 1/1999 regarding the state of siege and the emergency regime, published in the Official Journal of Romania, Part I, no. 22 of January 21, 1999, approved with modifications and completions by Law no. 453/2004, with the subsequent modifications and completions, of art. 2 and 3, para (3) of the Decree of the President of Romania no. 240/2020 concerning the extension of the state of emergency on Romania's territory,

Taking into account the assessment of the National Committee for Special Emergency Situations, approved by the Decision no. 22/11.05.2020.2020,

With the view to implementing the provisions of points 1 and 4 of the appendix no.2 to the Decree no.240/2020, based on art. 20, letter n) of the Government Emergency Ordinance no. 1/1999, approved with modifications and completions by Law no. 453/2004, with subsequent modifications and completions,

## The Minister of Home Affairs issues the following

## Military ordinance

- **Art. 1-** (1) The measure concerning the suspension of flights of economic airline operators towards Spain and from Spain to Romania, for all Romanian airports, is extended, starting with May, the 12<sup>th</sup>, 2020, until May, the 14<sup>th</sup>, included.
- (2) The measure provided for in para (1) does not apply to flights operated by state aircraft, cargo and correspondence flights, humanitarian or those providing emergency medical services, technical services, and non-commercial technical landings.
- **Art. 2-** (1) The Romanian maritime and river navigating personnel repatriated by any transportation means, is excepted from the measure of home isolation, if when entering the country, they do not show symptoms associated COVID-19 and the conditions stipulated in art.3 of the Military Ordinance no.9/2020 on measures for preventing the spread of COVID-19, are observed.
- (2) The measures shall apply from the date of publication of this military ordinance in the Official Journal of Romania, Part I.

- Art. 3- (1) The quarantine measure in the city of Tăndărei, Ialomița county, is lifted.
- (2) The measures shall apply from the date of publication of this military ordinance in the Official Journal of Romania, Part I.
- **Art.4** (1) The following institutions are empowered to ensure the application and observance of the provisions of this military ordinance:
  - a) The Ministry of Transports, Infrastructure and Communications, through the Romanian Civil Aeronautic Authority, for the measures provided in art.1;
  - b) The Romanian Border Police and the public health directorates, for the measure provided in art.2.
- (2) Failure to comply with the measures provided for in articles 1 and 2 shall lead to disciplinary, civil, contravention or criminal liability, in accordance with the legislation in force.
- Art.5- (1) This military ordinance shall be published in the Official Journal of Romania, Part I.
- (2) The audiovisual media service providers have the obligation to inform the public, through regularly broadcast messages, about the content of this military ordinance, for at least 2 days from the date of publication.
